

Procedure for Dental Injuries

Milk Teeth

Dental accidents involving deciduous teeth can cause damage to the permanent teeth still in the jaw.

Broken Milk Teeth

The more broken off, the more urgent it is to consult the dentist.

Loosened Milk Teeth

Treatment is not urgent (consult dentist within days).

Displaced Milk Teeth

Treatment is urgent. The tooth must be returned to its proper place as soon as possible. If possible, try to do it yourself immediately after the accident, to push the tooth/teeth back into the old position.

Knocked Out Milk Teeth

Treatment is not urgent, as it is not practical in most cases, to reinsert knocked out milk teeth (consult a dentist within days).

Milk Teeth Knocked In

Treatment is not always necessary. In any case, consult a dentist! (Highest risk for the permanent tooth!)

Permanent Teeth

The chance for long-term preservation of injured permanent teeth is the better, the faster the correct treatment (preferably within hours).

Chipped Permanent Teeth

Find large broken pieces, place them in cold water or, even better, in cold milk and bring them to the dentist. The more broken off, the more urgent treatment is.

Loosened and Displaced Permanent Teeth

Leave situation and do not manipulate teeth, close mouth only gently. Treatment is urgent. The tooth must be pressed into its proper place as soon as possible and possibly splinted.

Teeth Knocked Out

Find the tooth and touch it only at the crown, not at the root. If possible, return the tooth. If possible, immediately push the tooth back into the tooth socket yourself. If the tooth is visibly soiled, first rinse it with cold water. Rinse the tooth with cold water. If this is not possible, immerse the tooth without cleaning as quickly as possible in cold milk, sterile saline solution (doctor or pharmacy) or in special tooth rescue bottle with nutrient solution (Dentosafe®). In any case, consult the dentist immediately!

Inserted Teeth

See the dentist immediately! The tooth must be returned to its original position and splinted.
